# DISTRIBUTION FROM DUMAS

Centrally located in the country, Dumas is a distribution hub for transporting goods by road, rail, or air.

### **BY ROAD**

Dumas is located along Highways 87 and 287 of the Ports-to-Plains Trade Corridor, a multimodal transportation corridor that includes multilane divided highways. This highway system facilitates efficient with transportation of goods guaranteed 1-3-day delivery to an enormous area in the central United States. Just south of Dumas sits the eastwest conduit, Interstate 40. This ease of access is perfect for businesses that require a centrally located distribution hub. A 265-acre business park boasts highway access for added convenience. And for trucking companies looking for a skilled workforce, the local community college offers truck- driving courses, logistics & distribution training and many more offerings.

### **BY RAIL**

For those needing to distribute larger loads or oversized equipment, Dumas is located along the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad (BNSF) line and the Texas North-West (TNW) Logistics Center—the largest rail car park in North America. To increase efficiency and reduce additional distribution expenses, there are available business sites with rail access, and TNW has developed an Industrial Rail Park for your logistics needs. Because of its railroadhighway combination, Dumas works well for companies in need of 24-7 transloading.



# **BY AIR**

Near Dumas, the Moore County Airport has a 6,001-foot runway to accommodate jets. Just two minutes from Highway 287, it provides quick access from planes to major highways. The Aviation Business Park can accommodate your business needs. For companies requiring a larger airport, Amarillo International Airport is a 40-minute drive from Dumas.
